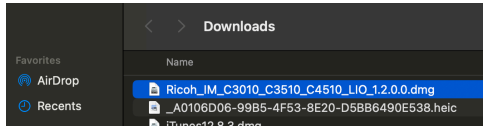

This PPD installer is used to install a PPD (Postscript Printer Description) file on Mac OSX. PPD files contain descriptions of printer capabilities such as paper sizes, number of input trays and duplexing. Once the PPD file is installed on the system using the PPD installer, the PS driver that comes bundled with Mac OS X can use the

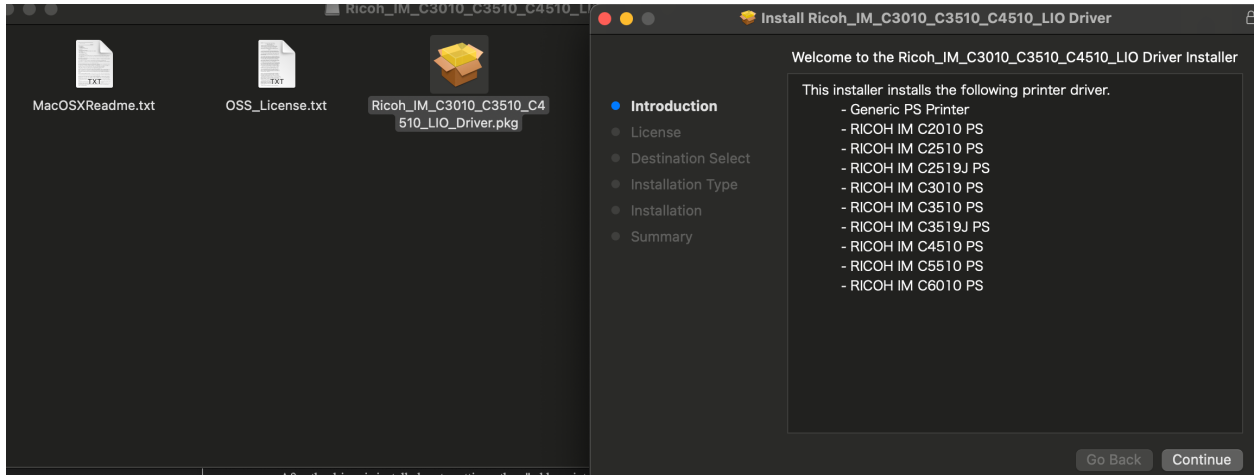

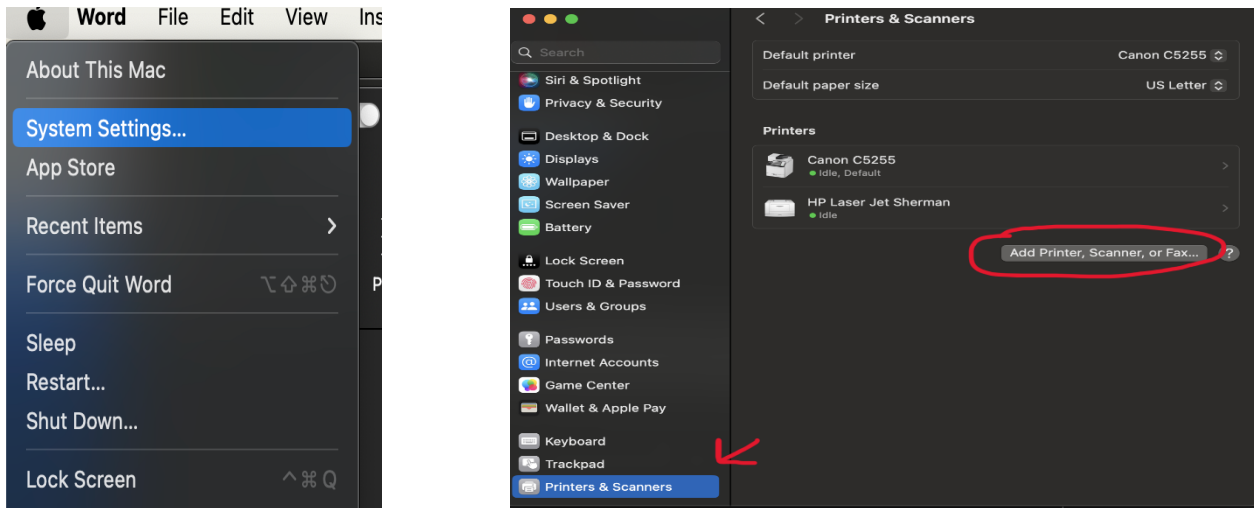
Open PPD Installer in Downloads



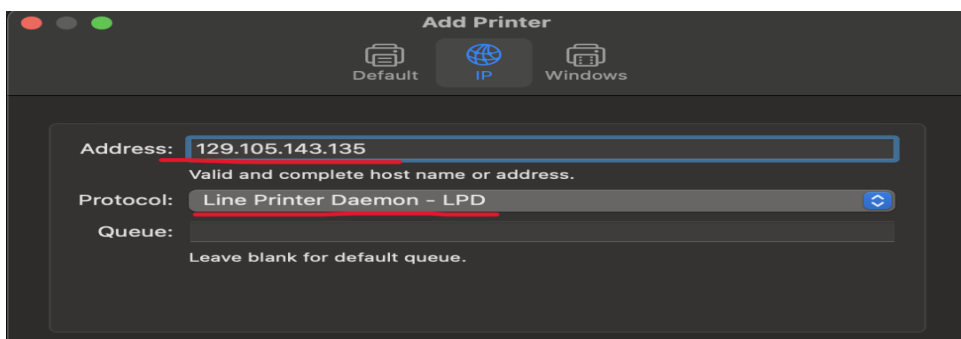
Run the pkg file and click through the prompts to complete the installation



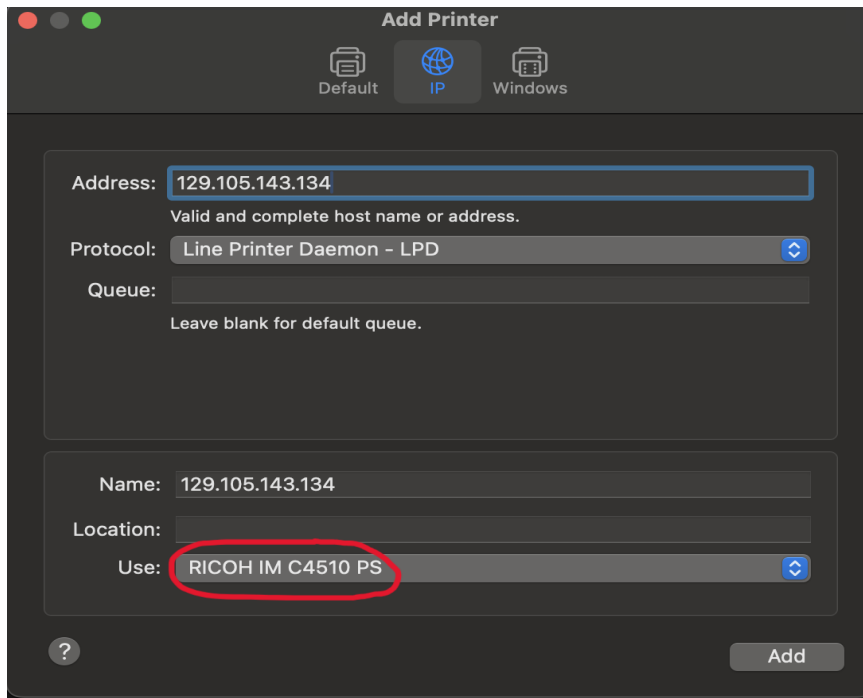
Now open the System settings application and add the printer



Enter IP address **129.105.143.134** and select the protocol **Line Printer Daemon**



If the printer and driver were added correctly, it should detect the printer model automatically
